Digital SAT Suite of Assessments

Last month, we announced the SAT® Suite of Assessments is going digital. The digital SAT will be delivered internationally in spring 2023 and in the U.S. in spring 2024. The PSAT/NMSQT® and PSAT™ 8/9 will be delivered digitally in fall 2023, with the PSAT™ 10 following in spring 2024.

While the transition to digital will bring a number of student- and educator-friendly changes, many important features of the SAT Suite will stay the same. The SAT Suite will continue to measure the knowledge and skills that students are learning in high school and that matter most for college and career readiness.
