

ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Make Sure Your AP Students Get the Credit They Earned

Each year a student takes an AP® Exam, they have the option to send one free score report to the college, university, or scholarship organization of their choice. Share instructions with them so they can activate their free score send by the June 20 deadline.

- AP Exams help students stand out, <u>no matter their score</u>.
- More colleges than ever before are accepting AP Exam scores for placement and credit.
- Nearly all colleges offer credit for the most popular AP courses.
- 3 out of 4 AP students who enrolled in a four-year college started school with some AP credit.

Remind your students:

"Your AP class is similar to the courses you'll experience at college. And like a college course, it's important to finish strong by taking your AP Exam and seeing the class through to the end. SAT Weekend

Registration for our last SAT of the spring, on June 4, is open for one more month. Encourage your juniors who haven't taken it yet to <u>register today</u>.

Students who've already taken the SAT should link their College Board accounts to Khan Academy® so they'll be well prepared to take it again in the summer or fall. We've seen encouraging results from students who use free Official SAT Practice from Khan Academy to raise their score, Like this student who was accepted into Brown University after practicing and retaking the SAT.
