Accessing Codes and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Delivering fee waivers through the [K–12 score reporting portal](#) is a streamlined process that allows access to benefits for all eligible students.

 On August 13, 2026, all existing fee waiver codes will expire. Schools will receive a new set of fee waiver codes (beginning with **FW26**) in your K–12 score reporting portal. Please be sure to distribute these new codes to all eligible students who have not yet entered one of the expiring codes in their account to activate their fee waiver benefits.

 Schools receive SAT® fee waivers through College Board’s K–12 score reporting portal in August and can use them for upcoming SAT administrations. In the K–12 score reporting portal, go to **Downloadable Reports**, then **Other Report Downloads**, and find the **2026 SAT Fee Waiver Codes.csv** file. You must have detail- or summary-level access to view these reports.

 If you need assistance accessing the K–12 score reporting portal, confirm you’re logged in to your school-level account. Then, ask your school’s access manager to grant you detail or summary access or consult the K–12 score reporting portal [Help page](#).

FAQs

How can I get access to the K–12 score reporting portal? I'm not authorized by my school to use the K–12 score reporting portal.

You can request access through your College Board professional account or by contacting your school's access manager. If you aren't authorized to use the portal, please contact your school's access manager or principal to generate and share the online fee waiver report.

Do all users of the portal receive the codes?

Codes will be delivered based on school code. Users from that school who have the Detailed Reports or Summary Reports will be able to download the Fee Waiver file report from **Other Report Downloads**.

In the custom reports from College Board, how will I know which file contains the fee waiver codes?

The fee waiver code file will be in an Excel file that uses the following naming convention: **[Start of School Year]_SAT_Fee_Waiver_Codes_[Your AI Code].csv**. For example, a school receiving fee waiver codes for the 2026-27 year with AI code 123456 would have a file named **2026_SAT_Fee_Waiver_Codes_123456.csv**. The new fee waiver codes will start with **FW26**. You should be able to open the .csv file using Microsoft Excel on a PC or the Numbers app on a Mac. If you have trouble opening the file, contact your IT department.

How will I know that the fee waiver code file is available?

If you have K–12 detail- or summary-level access to K–12 Assessment Reporting (as shown on your College Board professional account dashboard), you'll receive an email notification that a new file is available in the **Downloadable Reports** section under **Other Report Downloads**. Codes are typically available on August 13th.

How do I distribute fee waiver codes?

Schools use a variety of methods to distribute fee waiver codes to students. You should do what works best for your school. Some schools email the codes to students, offering an easy-to-find record of each fee waiver code and the date sent to each student. Emailing codes also allows students to copy and paste the code when registering online for the SAT. You may want to maintain and track the fee waiver codes that are distributed through the school year. Use the Roster Report to confirm students who have tested using a fee waiver code.

Can I save the fee waiver code file to my laptop/computer?

Yes. We recommend saving to a shared file so you and your colleagues can track code distribution together and avoid distributing the same code to different students.

How can I determine who has fee waiver benefits?

The Roster Report in the K–12 score reporting portal indicates whether a student has used a fee waiver to register for the SAT. In order to view which codes were used, please contact SAT Educator Support for a usage report.

What will happen to the fee waiver codes I was tracking before the new ones are sent in August?

The existing fee waiver codes will expire at 12:00 a.m. ET on August 13, 2026. After that time, the codes or the files containing them will no longer be accessible in your K–12 score reporting portal. If you are tracking any students who have one of these codes, encourage them to activate their benefits before the code expires on August 13. After that date, distribute new fee waiver codes to all eligible students. Benefits already loaded into students' College Board accounts can be used and will not expire.
