<b>OCT 4</b>	Preferred ordering deadline
<b>NOV 15</b>	Final ordering deadline for all full-year and first-semester AP® courses, and all exam only sections.
<b>MAR 14</b>	Ordering deadline for spring courses and to change fall exam orders
