Bluebook for In-School Assessments

Bluebook[™] is a custom digital exam application that students will use to take the SAT[®] and the PSAT-related assessments. This testing app makes the test day easier and faster for students and proctors. Bluebook supports testing on Mac and Windows devices, iPads, desktops, and school-managed Chromebooks. Bluebook must be installed before test day.

The app has been built to withstand internet outages. If the wi-fi drops during testing, students will still be able to progress through the test with no disruption. And if a student's computer runs out of battery power, they can simply plug in, restart their device, and pick up where they left off—all their work will be saved, and they won't lose testing time.

The test application includes many test tools that are designed to improve the test experience for students, including:

- A testing timer
- A built-in Desmos graphing calculator
- The ability to flag questions
- A simple navigator to jump to any question
- A math formula reference sheet
- Annotation via highlighter or note-writing
- Help and instructional screens
- Keyboard shortcuts
- Compatibility with screen readers and assistive technology

Students can practice and get familiar with the testing platform in advance by downloading Bluebook and taking a full-length practice test or trying out a test preview. For additional practice, students still have access to Khan Academy[®] learning resources, which include overviews, videos, articles, worked examples, and additional digital SAT questions for students to test their knowledge.

Approved testing accommodations will be provided in the Bluebook app. Students will be able to practice using their accommodations and assistive technology in advance of their test.
