Once your child uses the unique join code their AP<sup>®</sup> teacher gives them to join their class section online, they'll gain access to all the free resources available in AP Classroom. Your child can use these tools to stay on track with their coursework and prepare for AP Exams.



## TOPIC QUESTIONS AND PROGRESS CHECKS

Your child can sign in to their My AP account to access AP Classroom. If their AP teacher has assigned them, your child can use the topic questions and progress checks to gauge their understanding of course content and skills. They can track their learning in the My Reports section to check how they're progressing throughout the course.



## AP DAILY

Featuring real AP teachers, AP Daily videos are aligned directly to AP course content and skills. They can be accessed through AP Classroom and can be watched on any mobile device or computer with internet access. AP Daily videos are available for each topic in every unit, and they'll help build students' knowledge of course content and skills across units.

## Register for AP Exams

Regardless of their score, taking an AP Exam can help your child stay on track for college. And if your child scores a 3 or higher, they can earn college credit and/or placement at colleges across the country.

Encourage your child to talk to their AP teacher or coordinator about how they can register for exams for the AP courses they're taking this year before their school's deadline to sign up for AP Exams.
