2027 EXAM ORDERING DEADLINES

November 13, 2026, by 11:59 p.m. ET: Deadline to submit the order for full-year and fall semester courses and all exam only sections.

March 12, 2027, by 11:59 p.m. ET: Deadline to submit the exam order for all courses that begin after November 13 and to update fall orders (fees may apply for changes made to fall orders).

- **\$99:** AP Exams (including AP Seminar and AP Research) taken in the U.S., U.S. territories, Canada, and DoWEA schools.
- Late-order and late-testing fees: **\$40 per exam in addition to the base exam fee***
- Unused/canceled exam fee: **\$40 per exam***

PSAT/NMSQT AND PSAT 10

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is the qualifying test 11th grade students take in the fall to enter the National Merit® Scholarship Program and compete for recognition and college scholarships awarded in 2028. The PSAT 10, taken by 10th grade students in the spring, covers the same content areas as the PSAT/NMSQT and helps check progress and pinpoint areas for practice.

The PSAT 8/9, offered in the fall and spring, sets a readiness baseline for 8th and 9th grade students and helps monitor growth over time as they move through the SAT Suite.

2026-27 NEW AP COURSE FEE WAIVERS

Beginning in the 2026-27 school year, the AP Program will waive unused/canceled exam fees for a new AP course in the year the AP Program launches it. For 2026-27, this waiver applies to AP Business with Personal Finance and AP Cybersecurity.

2027 FEE REDUCTIONS

College Board provides a \$37 fee reduction per exam for eligible students. Schools are expected to forgo their \$9 rebate for these students, resulting in a cost of \$53 per exam (for international: \$83 per exam). Many states use federal and state funding to further reduce the exam fee for these students.
