Visit satpractice.org, create an account, and link your College Board and Khan Academy accounts for a plan based on your test results.
- **Receive AP course recommendations.** Your score report identifies AP® courses that are the best match for you. AP can give you an edge in the admission process and earn you college credit while in high school, which saves time and money in college.
