- **Get free, personalized SAT practice.** The PSAT/NMSQT is great preparation for the SAT®. Your score unlocks free, personalized practice through Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy®. Visit [satpractice.org](https://satpractice.org), create an account, and link your College Board and Khan Academy accounts for a plan based on your test results.
- **Receive AP course recommendations.** Your score report identifies AP® courses that are the best match for you. AP can give you an edge in the admission process and earn you college credit while in high school, which saves time and money in college.
- **Explore Careers.** Connect with **Roadmap to Careers** under the **Popular Tools** tab in your score report. Answer questions about what you like to do to see careers that interest you, what degrees you'll need, and what high school courses to take. Watch video interviews with people in professions related to your interests.
